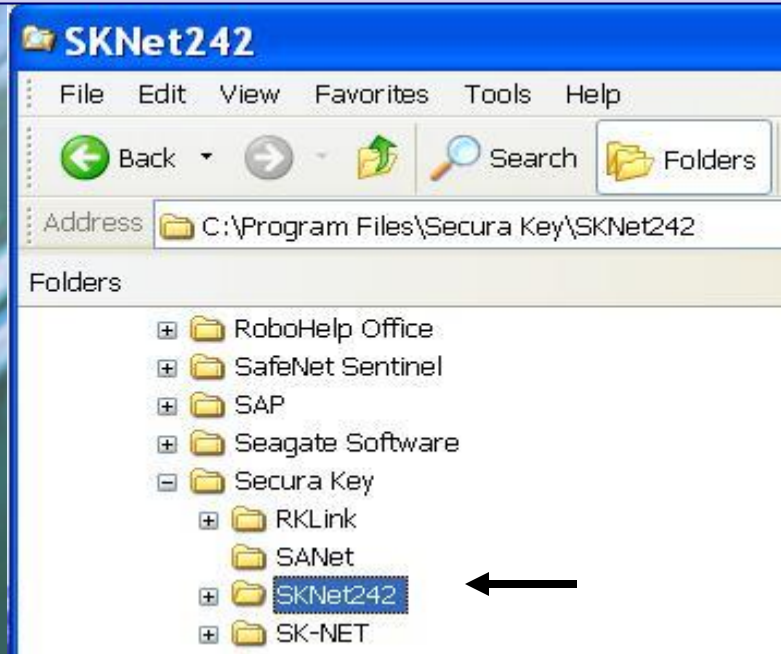
Upgrade SK-NET or Changing Computers

You may need to upgrade SK-NET software because of features that the newer software has to offer or need extended access

- **Upgrades** for basic versions can be made at no charge
- **Upgrading to MLD or Client Server** versions you will need to purchase the appropriate version
- **Changing Computers:** In either case your existing database files become very important so you will not have to rebuild your system from scratch

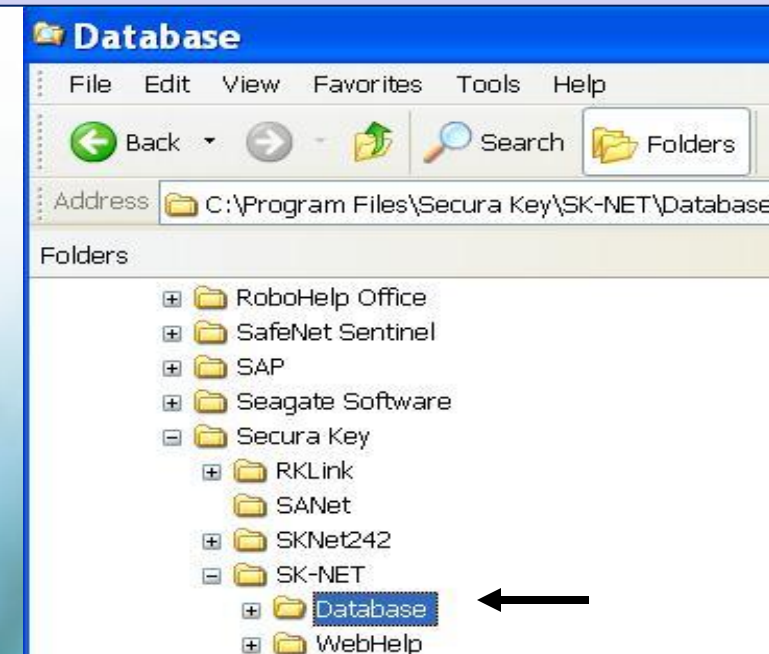
If you are using version 2 of SK-NET

copy the entire SK-NET 2.42 folder to a USB drive or somewhere on your local network.



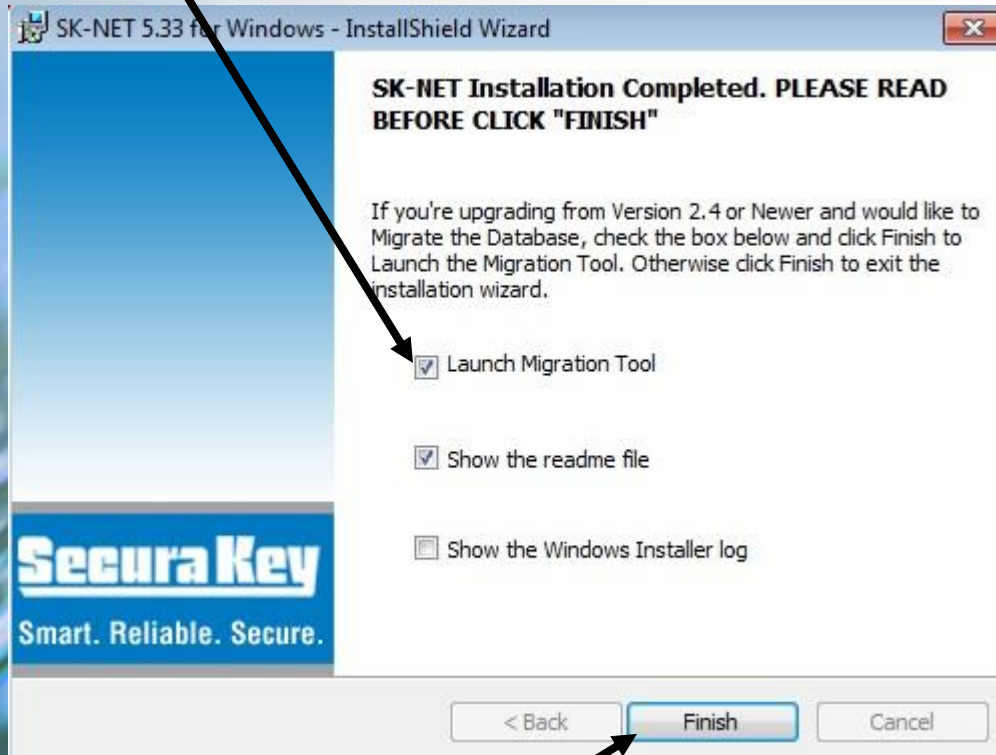
If you are using versions 3, 4, or 5 of SK-NET

copy only the database folder to a USB drive or somewhere on your local network.

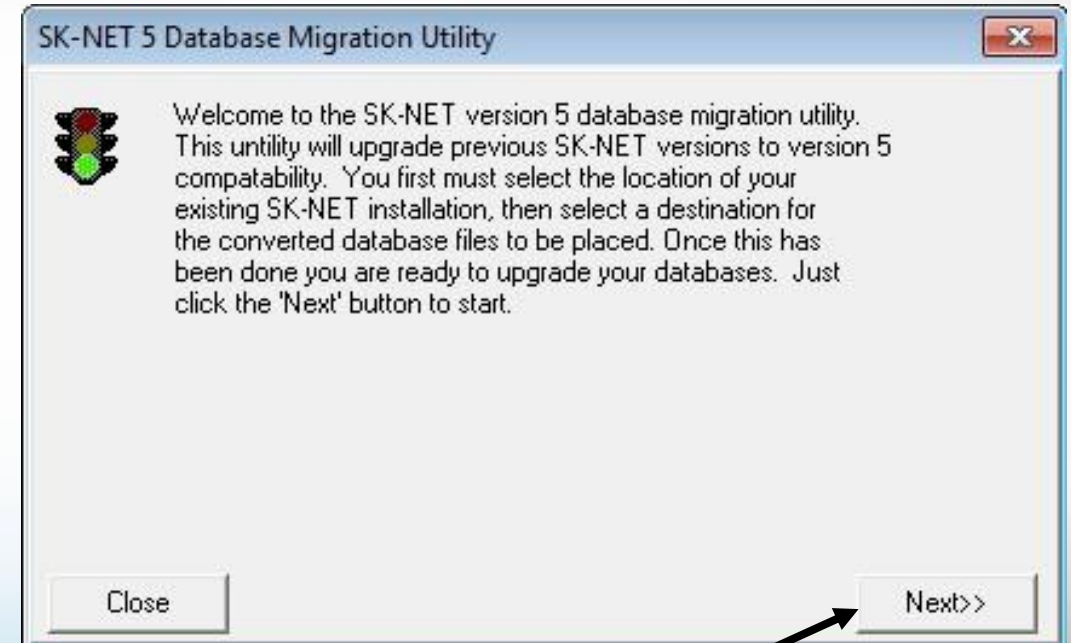


Upgrade SK-NET or Changing Computers

At the end of the SK-NET installation
Check 'Launch Migration Tool' box



Click on Finish to start the Migration Tool

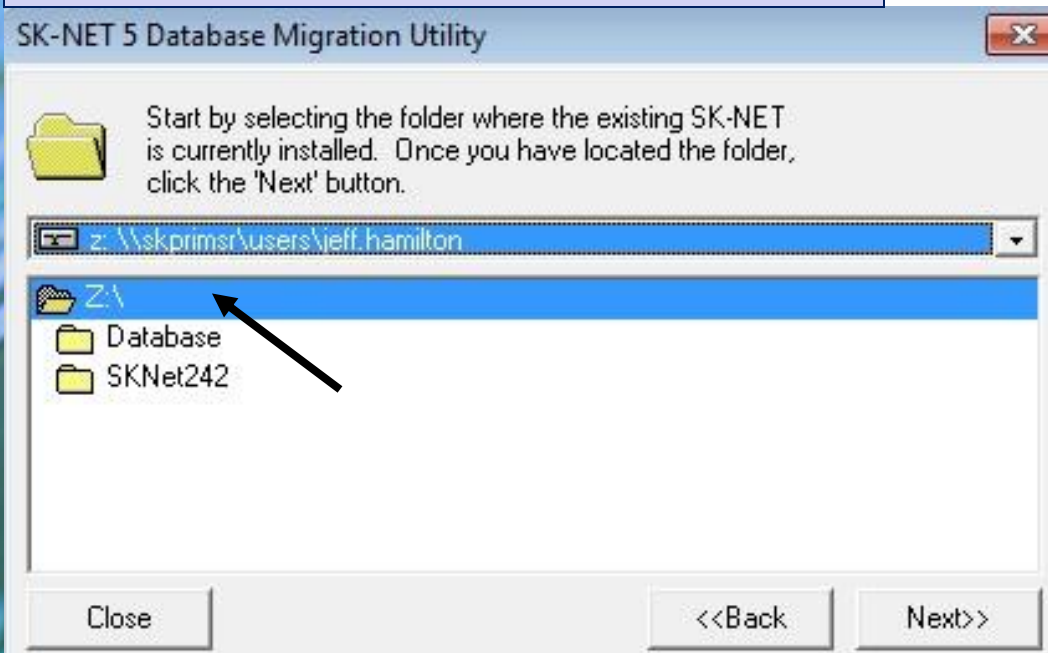


Select Next

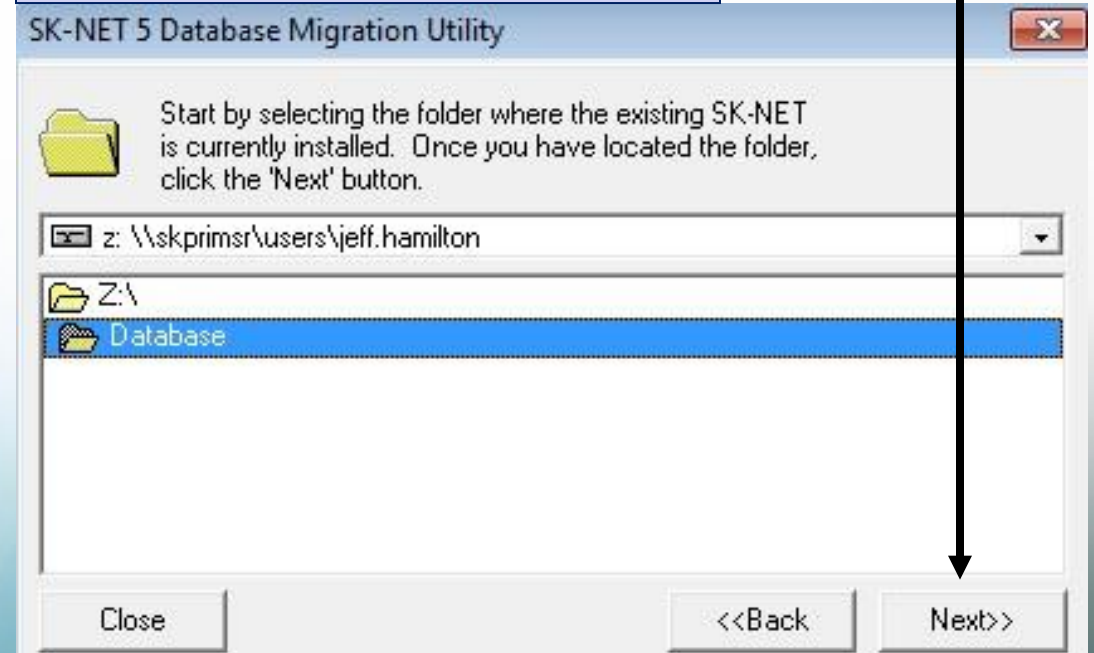
Upgrade SK-NET or Changing Computers

The Migration Utility will now ask where your original database files are located

Point to the USB drive or on the network where your original files are located



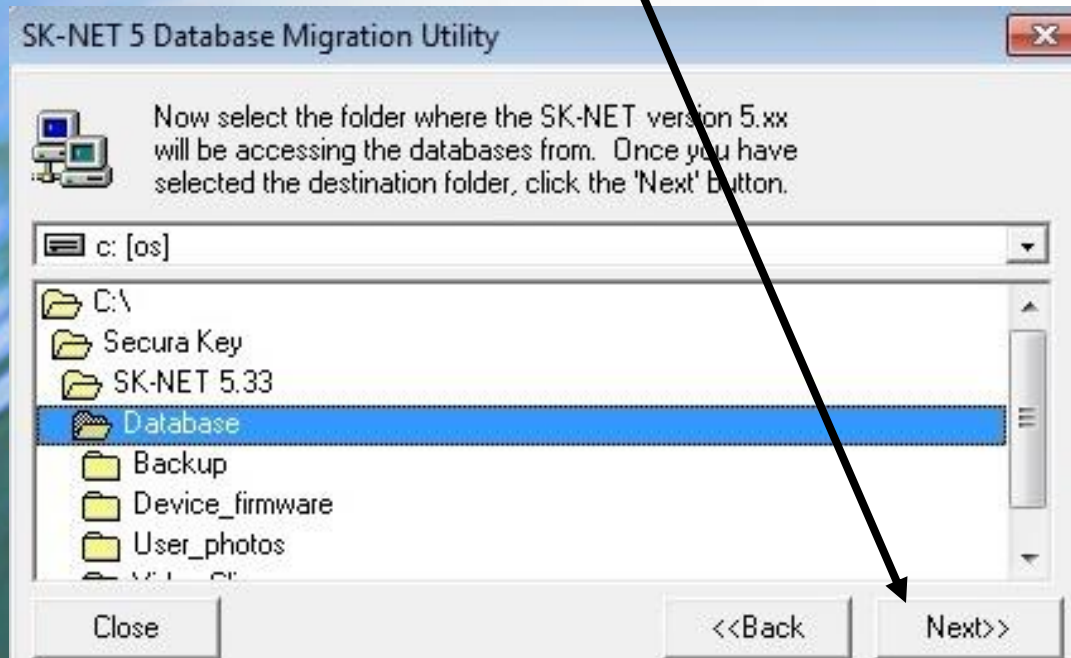
Select the folder and double click to make it appear that it is open



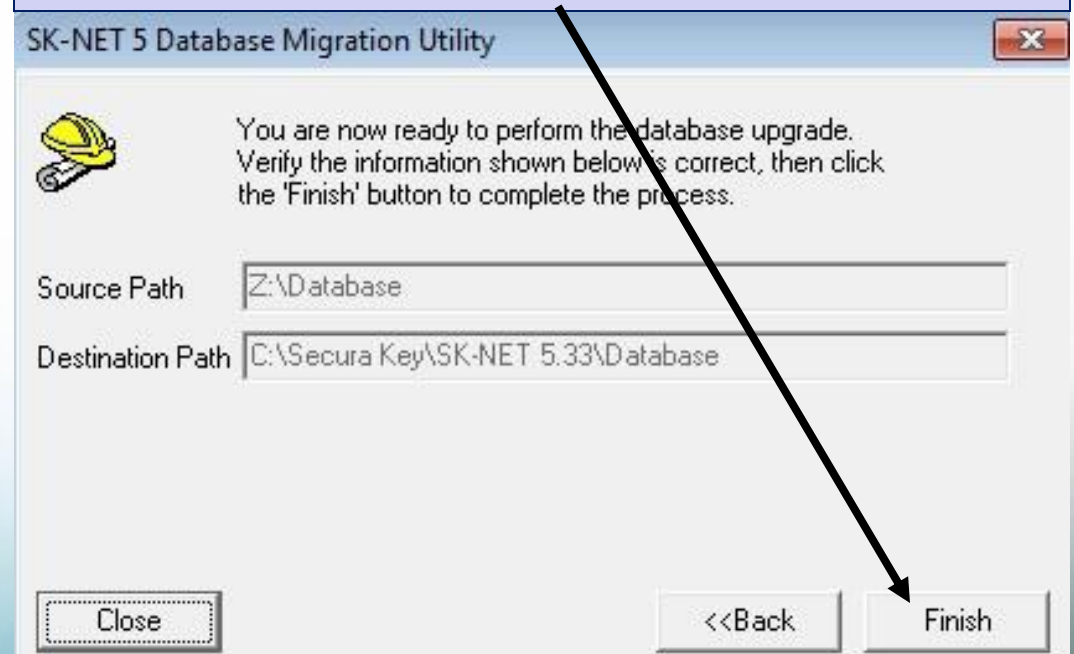
Upgrade SK-NET or Changing Computers

It is now pointing to the database folder for your new installation

This is the default, **Select Next**



Select Finish to start the file transfer into your new installation of SK-NET



Start SK-NET and verify that all your data has been imported properly
